The Public Safety Committee met at the Ontario County Safety Training Facility on Tuesday, September 6, 2016. Chairman Green called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

**Supervisor Bendzlowicz moved approval of the Regular and Budget Minutes of August 15, 2016. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

**District Attorney:**

Mr. Tantillo requested authorization to accept a Renewal of Crimes Against Revenue Program Grant.

**Supervisor Evangelista moved approval of the renewal as requested by Mr. Tantillo. Supervisor Bendzlowicz seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

**Planning:**

Mr. Harvey requested authorization for Approval of Contract Amendment #2 with McFarland-Johnson, Inc. for Professional Consultant and Engineering Services - Capital Project 6-2015 (Closing of Geneva PSAP).

**Supervisor Bendzlowicz moved approval of the contract amendment as requested by Mr. Harvey. Supervisor Ingalsbe seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

**Probation:**

Mr. Rougeux requested authorization to contract with Ontario County Mental Health for Juvenile Mental Health Treatment.

**Supervisor Hilton moved approval of the contract as requested by Mr. Rougeux. Supervisor Evangelista seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

**Emergency Management:**

Mr. Harloff requested authorization for payment of Finger Lakes Communication Invoice in the amount of \$29,357.47 (SHSP FY 2014 Grant – CP 6-12). This will close out the grant. There was brief discussion.

**Supervisor Ingalsbe moved approval of the payment as requested by Mr. Harloff. Supervisor Bendzlowicz seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

**Office of Sheriff:**

Sheriff Povero requested authorization to apply for State Homeland Security Grants as follows. He briefly explained each grant.

- A. FY2016 Critical Infrastructure Grant Program
- B. FY2016 tactical team Targeted Grant Program
- C. FY2016 Explosive Detection Canine Team Grant Program

**Supervisor Bendzlowicz moved approval of the three grant applications listed above as requested by Sheriff Povero. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Sheriff Povero requested authorization to accept Grants from the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee:

- A. Grant – Police Traffic Services Program
- B. Grant – Child Passenger Safety Program

**Supervisor Evangelista moved approval for acceptance of the two grants listed above as requested by Sheriff Povero. Supervisor Ingalsbe seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Sheriff Povero requested authorization for Assignment of contract with Correctional Eye Care Network Services, Inc. They have been acquired by National Eye Care Inc. This will reflect the correct name on the contract.

**Supervisor Bendzlowicz moved approval for the assignment of contract as requested by Sheriff Povero. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Sheriff Povero requested authorization for Acceptance of Bids for the Purchase of Law Enforcement Accessories and Leather Goods. There are two vendors, each with a one year contract and option for renewal.

**Supervisor Evangelista moved approval for acceptance of bids as requested by Sheriff Povero. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Sheriff Povero requested authorization for Acceptance of Bids for the Purchase Prisoner Uniforms and Linens. There are four vendors, each with a one year contract and option for two renewals.

**Supervisor Evangelista moved approval for acceptance of bids for the Jail as requested by Sheriff Povero. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Sheriff Povero updated the Committee on temporary position requests as follows for employees that are out on Disability: County Police Officer position for up to six months and a Registered Professional Nurse position for up to 90 days. These temporary positions will help reduce the overtime costs.

Sheriff Povero updated the Committee on the Jail population. Today's count is 192 and the weekend high was 208. Male juveniles are being housed in Wayne County. There are currently 50 females incarcerated.

Sheriff Povero spoke about the heroin abuse issues. There were two Narcan saves by Deputies over the weekend. The supply of Narcan is running low and we have asked the state to replenish it but haven't received any yet. Sheriff's Office is working with Purchasing regarding the possibility of purchasing this item.

On behalf of Town of Farmington Justice Gligora, Supervisor Ingalsbe requested authorization for a Resolution of Thank You for Justice Edwin Williams, who retired on July 31 after 45 years of service.

**Supervisor Hilton moved approval as requested by Supervisor Ingalsbe. Supervisor Campbell seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**

Chairman Green asked for remembrance of the 9-1-1 victims and their families.

**At 2:19 p.m., Supervisor Bendzlowicz moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Ingalsbe seconded the motion, carried unanimously.**
