### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting of the Public Safety Committee was called to order at 11:00 a.m. by Chairman Green.

### **MINUTES**

Supervisor Westbrook made a motion to approve the minutes of the Public Safety Committee meeting from January 17, 2018 as corrected. Supervisor Venuti seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### **CAMPBELL COMMISSION**

The Campbell Commission next meeting will be held on February 8, 2018. Mr. Rougeux did a presentation on the impact of the FLACRA weekend program and the electronic home monitoring program. The FLACRA program has reduced the number of people serving weekends at the jail by 20%. Saving 710 jail days and \$69,850 to the county since May of 2017. This program has a 91% satisfaction rating from its participants. The pre-trial electronic home monitoring program has 13 people participating in the program. This program has saved 664 jail days and \$115,026.08 before the Hakes ruling.
