	<p>County Administrator Chris DeBolt gave the following updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The number of new COVID cases of staff members out on either positive isolation or on quarantine is down significantly. • They are working with the school superintendents to work out the vaccines with the school personnel. • They have been working intensely over the last week on the Police Reform and Reinvention Collaborative. They have split out into subgroups to really dig down to get the stakeholders more engaged. The draft plan is on the Public Safety Agenda. <p>Chairman Marren stated that last week, the Governor announced that Phase 1B was expanding to restaurant workers and taxi, uber, and lyft drivers. The Control Room met collectively; the consensus was that they are not going to allow this portion of our population to vaccinate for the following reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not enough guidance from the state • Not enough vaccines
