

GOLDEN SPOT SENIOR CENTER

The Golden Spot Senior Center is located in Canandaigua at the Salvation Army (110 Saltonstall St). Activities are planned every day Monday thru Friday and lunch is provided by Ontario County Office for the Aging nutrition program. Come join us.

Who is eligible?

Seniors aged 60 and over are eligible for all activities.

How do you join the Golden Spot?

Walk-ins are welcome. Those interested will be asked to complete a brief form upon arrival. The form requests general information such as name and address, as well as information to be utilized in the event of an emergency.

Is it necessary to sign up ahead for activities?

Seniors are welcome to drop in for activities, but the Salvation Army would prefer that interested seniors call ahead especially in the case of trips.

Where do the activities take place?

With the exception of the yearly trip, all the activities are held in the Senior Lounge.

When do the activities take place?

Activities are scheduled from 9:00 to 2:00 on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; and 10:00 to 3:00 on Tuesday and Thursday. Please refer to the Center's monthly calendar for exact dates and times of scheduled events. The calendars are available at the Salvation Army. You may place your name on their mailing list.

What types of activities does the Golden Spot offer?

- ✓ Bingo and Table Games
- ✓ Ceramics
- ✓ Trips – one a year
- ✓ Parties
- ✓ Blood Pressure checks

What is the cost of participating?

There is a suggested donation for the noon meal provided by OFA. There is also a cost for the monthly lunch outing depending on where you go. If you are involved in Ceramics there is a cost for greenware (SA provides the paint). With these exceptions, there is no cost to any seniors wishing to join the fun.
