

MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR III

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Employees in this class primarily operate semi-tractor trailer equipment and other heavy construction equipment and maintenance equipment used in public works activities. This class differs from Motor Equipment Operator II due to the more complex nature of the equipment operated. Employees in this class must exercise significant judgment in over the road transport of heavy equipment and substances such as leachate in tank trailers. Employees may operate various types of heavy trucks and construction equipment when not driving a semi-tractor trailer. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Operates semi-tractor equipment in transport of heavy construction equipment and landfill leachate in tanker trailers;
 Operated bulldozers, loaders, graders, pavers, rollers, backhoes, 10-wheel trucks, and tractor mounted peripheral equipment;
 Maintains required logs for equipment mandated by outside agencies;
 Maintains preventive maintenance records;
 Performs preventive maintenance activities on equipment;
 Lays black top on roads with a paving machine;
 Cleans ditches, levels dirt, spreads stones, and removes snow and ice from roads with a grader;
 Cuts trees, weeds, and brush in connection with highway maintenance;
 Sets guard rails and posts;
 Sands highways and plows snow;
 Performs a variety of manual tasks;
 May, on assignment, operate other types of equipment which may be more or less complicated.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Thorough knowledge of the operation and care of heavy duty road maintenance equipment; ability to make simple repairs to equipment; ability to maintain required logs for equipment in appropriate formats (written or computer); ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; willingness to respond to emergencies and perform overtime work; willingness to work outside under adverse weather conditions; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

QUALIFICATIONS:

County Values: All employees of Ontario County are expected to uphold and exhibit the County's shared values and behaviors to achieve the County's Vision and Mission.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Three (3) years of full-time paid experience, or its part-time equivalent, in the operation of motor equipment, one year of which must have been in the operation of heavy equipment such as tractor trailers, backhoe, bulldozer or related road maintenance equipment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT AT TIME OF APPLICATION: Possession of a valid Class A New York State Commercial Driver's License with appropriate endorsements, with no restrictions at the time of application, and maintenance of such license throughout the tenure of employment in the position.
