

WATER PLANT ATTENDANT

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is routine manual work involving responsibility for assisting in the operation and maintenance of equipment and cleaning and maintenance of the building and grounds at the water treatment plant. The work is performed under the immediate supervision of the Water Treatment Plant Operator.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Assists in the operation of pumps, valves, motors, and related machinery and equipment;
Changes chlorine and acid cylinders;
Records readings of meters and gauges;
Repairs water meters;
Mows lawns, trims shrubs, rakes leaves and performs a variety of other groundskeeping tasks;
May perform minor maintenance tasks.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Willingness to perform routine manual work; mechanical ability; ability to lift heavy weights; physical endurance; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Six months of experience in building or equipment maintenance activities.

NOTE: Documented part-time or volunteer experience will be accepted on a prorated basis.
